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**Meals On Wheels In Need of Volunteers In Mansfield as Number of People
Needing Meals Continues to Increase**

Meals On Wheels, Inc. of Tarrant County is in need of volunteers to deliver meals in Mansfield. A drastic increase in clients has resulted in the need for additional delivery routes, which means a need for more volunteers. Since Meals On Wheels doesn't place clients on a waiting list, the need is especially urgent.

Volunteering for Meals On Wheels is not only rewarding, but easy to do. In just over one hour a week, a volunteer can make a huge difference in the life of a homebound senior by providing them with nourishment and a friendly face; something many homebound people don't receive regularly.

Meals On Wheels volunteers are asked to help one day each week by picking up meals at a designated distribution site between 10:30 and 11:00 a.m. and delivering them to the homebound. The distribution site in Mansfield is located at First United Methodist Church, 777 N. Walnut Creek Drive. Training is provided. Background checks are required. Volunteers use their own vehicles for delivery and must provide proof of insurance.

Meals On Wheels volunteers come from all areas of our community. Some have a regular route they deliver one day each week; others work as substitutes to help when regular drivers are out because of illness or vacations. Many companies adopt a Meals On Wheels route to share their one day a week delivery among employees.

Volunteer today. Organizations such as Meals On Wheels could not be successful in serving the needs of the community without the dedication of volunteers.
