Meals On Wheels Closes on Future Property Site

Meals On Wheels, Inc. of Tarrant County purchased 9.2 acres located on the south side of SH 121 just west of Carson Road on May 10. Executive Director Carla Jutson reports the need for home-delivered meals from the agency is growing rapidly and projects it will serve 51% more meals in 2020 than in 2010. Since the program began in 1973, more than 14 million meals have been delivered to homebound elderly and disabled residents of Tarrant County. Last year alone, the agency's caring volunteers delivered 985,187 meals to 4,255 clients.

Meals On Wheels, Inc. of Tarrant County is preparing to launch "Building for the Future," a capital campaign to build a new facility with a kitchen that will accommodate the significant growth projections in 2020 and beyond.

The new building will also provide much needed space for other programs such as Client Services, Neighbor Helping Neighbor, Companion Pet Meals, and future programs needed to help the homebound remain safe and independent in their own home... where they most want to be.
